



BEEFING UP Backpacks

2025 FINAL REPORT

The PA Beef Foundation is the 501c3 nonprofit initiative behind the Beefing Up Backpacks program. This program helps fight childhood hunger by adding a nutritious 1-oz beef stick to weekend food backpacks distributed across Pennsylvania. These programs rely on donations and grant funds to feed kids facing food insecurity, and currently, less than 2% of backpack contents include animal protein. So far, 5,000 lbs. of beef have been converted into beef sticks, opening an emerging, underutilized market segment for the beef sector. By providing shelf-stable, high-quality beef sticks, we're bridging this nutritional gap and supporting healthy growth for children in need.

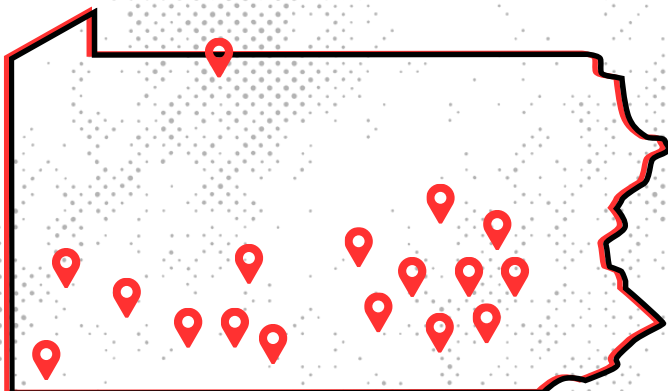
